Criteria	Rating
Introduction: (Overall Rating)	Avg:
You use five sentence starters to clearly inform the reader the information necessary to understand the paper	
Information is in your own words	
You cite at least 4-5 reputable background sources	
Objective: (Overall Rating)	Avg:
You have clearly stated your hypothesis	
The purpose of this study is clearly stated	
Two sentence starters (or appropriate variation) are used	
Your information is correct	
Procedure: (Overall Rating)	Avg:
Procedures are listed in clear steps.	
Each step is numbered and is a complete sentence.	
All materials used during sampling are included in a bulleted list.	
Data and Results: (Overall Rating)	Avg:
Accurate representation of the data in a minimum of 1 table and 1 graph.	
Graphs and tables are labeled and titled.	
Correct units are used.	
Discussion: (Overall Rating)	Avg:
The relationship between the variables is discussed and trends/patterns logically analyzed.	

Predictions are made about what might happen if part of the lab were changed or how the study design could be changed.	
You have included possible sources of error	
Conclusion: (Overall Rating)	Avg:
Includes whether the hypothesis is supported/ unsupported/ inconclusive by the data	
You included 2-3 sentences of what was learned during the study.
